A message from Life Floor CEO Jonathan Keller

Last year, Life Floor renewed our core commitments to aquatic safety and design, guaranteeing a world-class experience for everyone who comes in contact with our products.

To start, we engineered the best to be even better. Life Floor's new Ripple 2.0 (We've been calling it "Gripple" around the office, much to the amusement of our Brand team) takes all the trusted features of our classic texture and increases performance dramatically (page 6). Inspired by a determination to reduce hydroplaning on splash pads, we cannot wait to get our new, improved Ripple in wet areas around the world.

This spring, we founded the Life Floor Studio, a creative new initiative to better serve our partners in the architecture and design space, with the added goal of providing affordable, beautifully designed decks and splash pads to local communities. Our Studio has already produced nearly 200 unique designs. Of these, we're incredibly proud of the Cedarcrest Splash Pad, right in our own backyard in Bloomington, Minnesota (page 26). Life Floor is partnering with municipalities across the United States to produce more outstanding designs, merging aquatic safety with public art to create installations that are sure to be a focal point for any community.

As always, we've completed more projects in 2017 than this publication could ever contain. This year we added installations in the Middle East, Europe, East Asia, Australia, Caribbean, Canada and Mexico, and worked with partners at home, including LEGOLAND® California, Great Wolf Lodge, and Cedar Fair. Life Floor can be found on cruise lines like Carnival and Norwegian, and we're working on amazing projects across the world, with many of the leading brands in hospitality and aquatic entertainment. Perhaps most importantly, we're continuing to partner with NSF to create a safety standard for aquatic surfaces and simultaneously working with local communities to bring aquatic safety surfacing to as many people as possible.

This Lookbook contains a small sampling of the incredible work our team has done this year, riding the wave on our mission to make aquatic environments safer, more beautiful, and more fun.

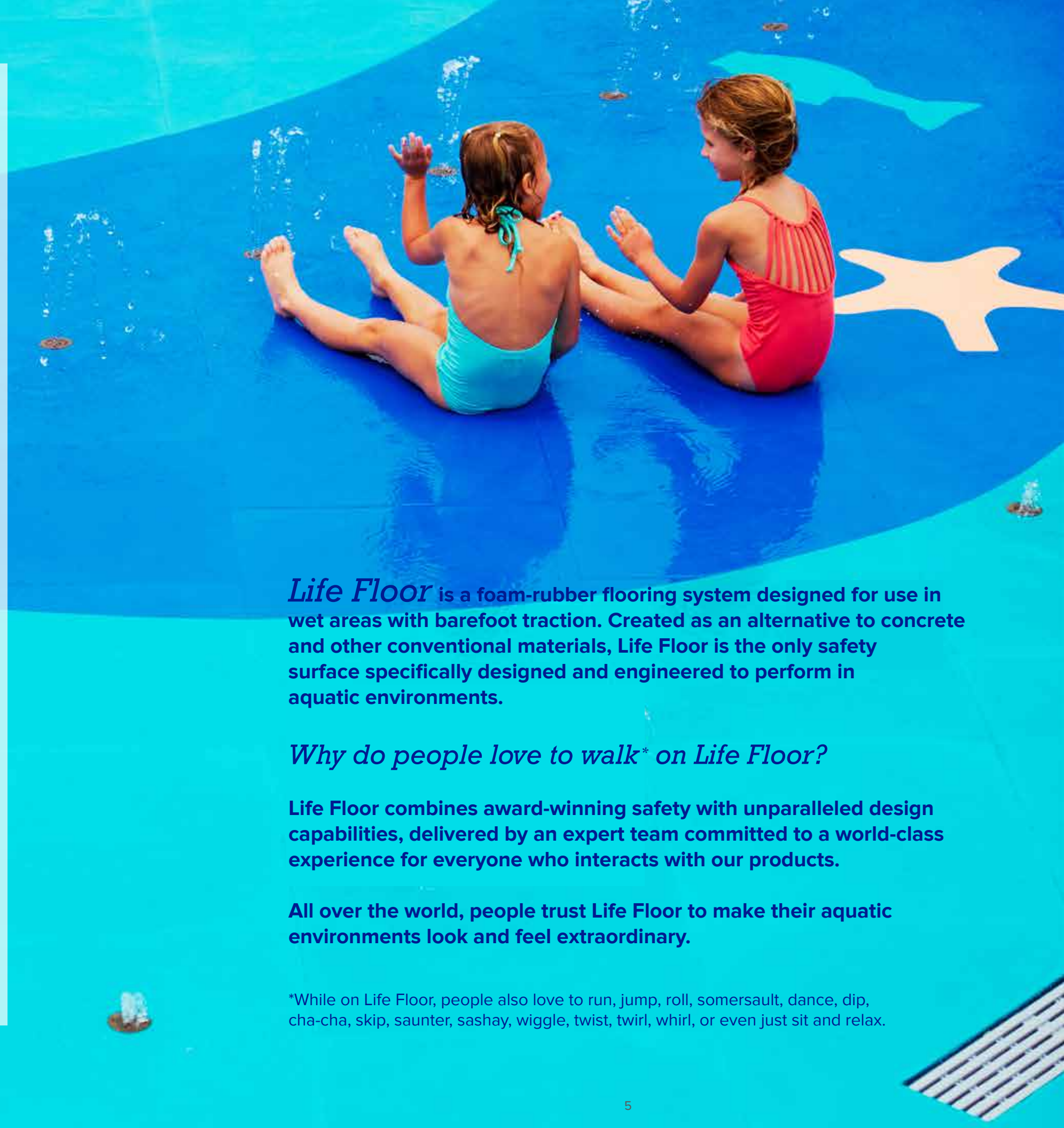

Life Floor is a foam-rubber flooring system designed for use in wet areas with barefoot traction. Created as an alternative to concrete and other conventional materials, Life Floor is the only safety surface specifically designed and engineered to perform in aquatic environments.

Introducing Ripple Version 2.0

The best just got even better.

For years, **Ripple** has been our most slip-resisting texture and our best-selling product. All over the world, people trust Life Floor's Ripple to perform where everything else has failed, and Ripple delivers.

As we completed over a thousand projects, we discovered ways that we could improve our industry-leading texture. **Deeper grooves to further reduce hydroplaning. A more tactile surface that looks and feels as slip-resistant as it is.**

Inspired by our partners in waterparks and splash pads around the world, our designers and engineers collaborated for months to arrive at a set of prototype tiles. These tiles were then field-tested on actual, municipal splash pads throughout Summer 2017.

After completing the season, and passing a battery of expert-designed performance trials, the **verdict was unanimous.** The result is a product that not only lives up to the

reputation of Ripple, but surpasses it in every imaginable way.

Introducing Ripple 2.0, or as we sometimes call it, "Gripple." While extensive laboratory testing has proven that this is our **best-performing Life Floor tile, ever,** that's not the only reason we know that we can trust it. As parents, we know firsthand that Life Floor does what we say it does, because our kids play on it, too.

Deeper grooves to further reduce hydroplaning.

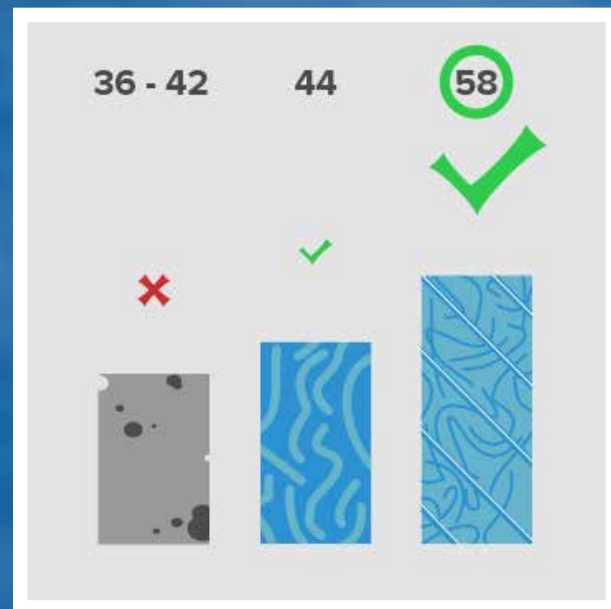
Hydroplaning happens in wet areas when water accumulates and creates a layer between your feet and the ground, resulting in a loss of traction. A splash pad may be especially prone to hydroplaning due to the volumes of water frequently running over its surface.

How does Ripple reduce hydroplaning?

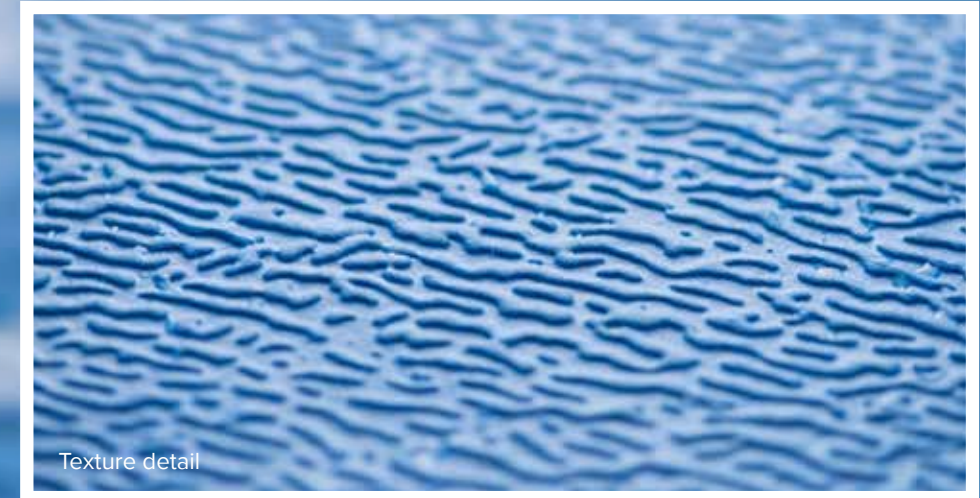
Believe it or not, Ripple has always worked on the same principle as your car's all-weather tires. Grooves called siping allow water to run away from the surface into channels, insuring that the tire is actually meeting the road, or in our case, that your foot is hitting the floor. Our engineers discovered that, by increasing the depth of Ripple's grooves by 75%, we could not only increase overall traction, but specifically increase protection against hydroplaning.

And how has overall traction improved?

At Life Floor, we utilize the British Pendulum Test for surface slip-resistance, which we believe best reproduces real-world conditions in the laboratory testing environment. Recommended British Pendulum Numbers (BPN) for splash pad is over 40. Conventional surfaces, like concrete, have a BPN ranging between 36-42. Ripple Classic has a top BPN of 44, and Ripple 2.0 has a BPN of 58. With a BPN nearly 40% greater than concrete, without being abrasive, Ripple 2.0 is our most slip-resistant texture, ever!

Texture detail

A gentle deterrent:

When encountering a safety surface as comfortable as Life Floor, some guests like to really push the limits of physical activity. As a gentle reminder that safety is everyone's responsibility, Ripple's new, improved texture features a more tactile grip, while still maintaining the comfortable, non-abrasive surface you expect from Life Floor.

More dramatic relief:

Deeper grooves also mean a more defined texture, and a crisper, more polished look for your aquatic facility.

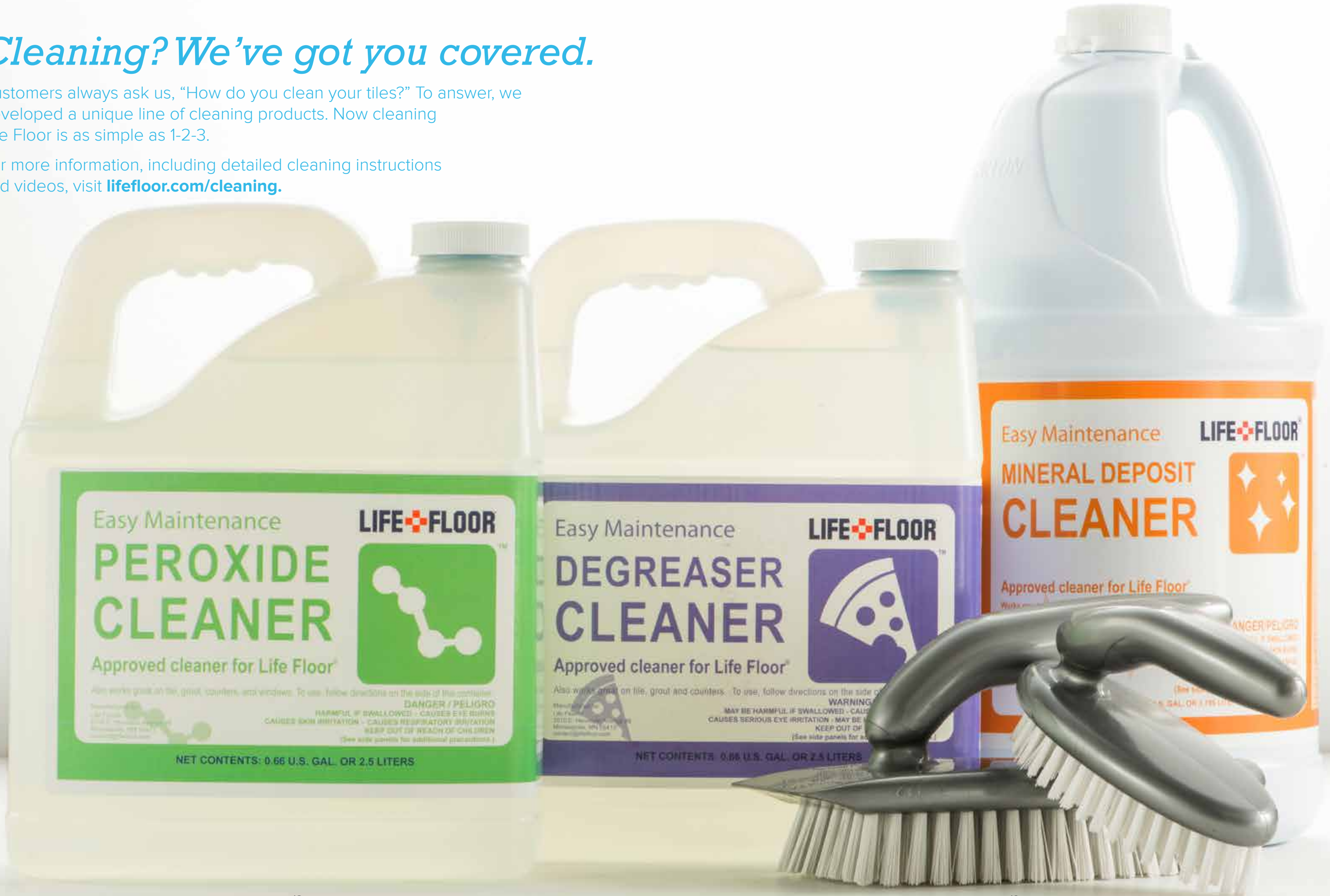

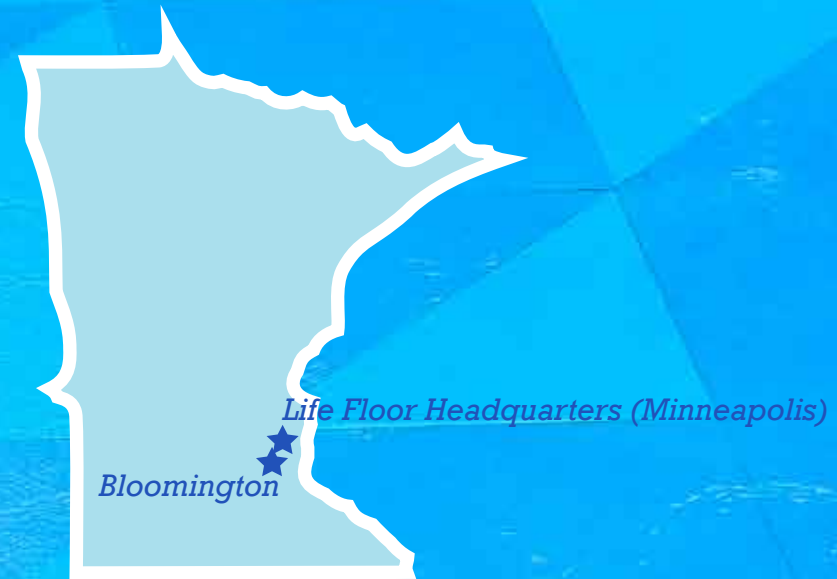

Custom Die-Cuts

One of the “secrets” to LEGOLAND® California's theming is that everything in the Park is built to the scale of actual LEGO® bricks. **Surfers' Cove** is built at 25:1 scale... in this case, it would take 25 LEGO® fish (**Part 64648** for those keeping track at home) laid in a row to equal the length of one Life Floor, custom die-cut fish.

Field-Testing The Future at Cedarcrest Splash Pad

This summer, our team had an incredible opportunity to trial our most innovative new products, virtually in our own backyard.



Partnering with the City of Bloomington, Minnesota, we worked to revamp their 1,500 square foot splash pad at **Cedarcrest Park.**

Cedarcrest Splash Pad features the first examples of two important concepts - our incredible, enhanced texture, **Ripple 2.0** (Page 6), and a geometric, gradient pattern, created with a new, affordable die-cut process and designed by the **Life Floor Studio.**

With a more slip-resisting, durable, and beautiful solution for municipal parks and other community spaces, created within the parameters of a real-world, public budget, **Cedarcrest Splash Pad** truly represents the future of Life Floor and, we think, of municipal splash pads everywhere. ▶▶

Durability Testing In Public Space

In developing the new, enhanced version of Ripple (page 6), our research and development team wanted a true test of the texture's **anti-hydroplaning capabilities** and durability against the normal wear and tear of public, outdoor environments.

Cedarcrest Splash Pad is a fenceless, public splash pad that is completely exposed to the elements, including shoe traffic from community members.

Essentially, the location was perfect.



While there are many beautiful splash pads across the Twin Cities, the Cedarcrest Park Splash Pad is unique in that the splash pad is completely open. Bikes ride over it, shoes run across it, and trees line the outer perimeter with a dry playground nearby. This means that the splash pad is covered with leaves, sticks, dirt, sand, gravel, and wood chips on a regular basis.

With the summer season at an end, our development team is pleased to find that Life Floor weathers the outdoors and public spaces extremely well. Life Floor tiles remain adhered, the surface can be easily cleaned from dirt, debris, and leaves, colors appear vibrant, and our slip-resisting texture is just as slip-resisting as the beginning of the season.

“There are different levels of complexity in designing with Life Floor squares: at the very basic level, of course, a design can be entirely squares. At the next level of design, you might add triangles, curves, and then to add complexity, die-cut shapes. This project is a great example of how using basic squares and triangles can be very effective and interesting.”

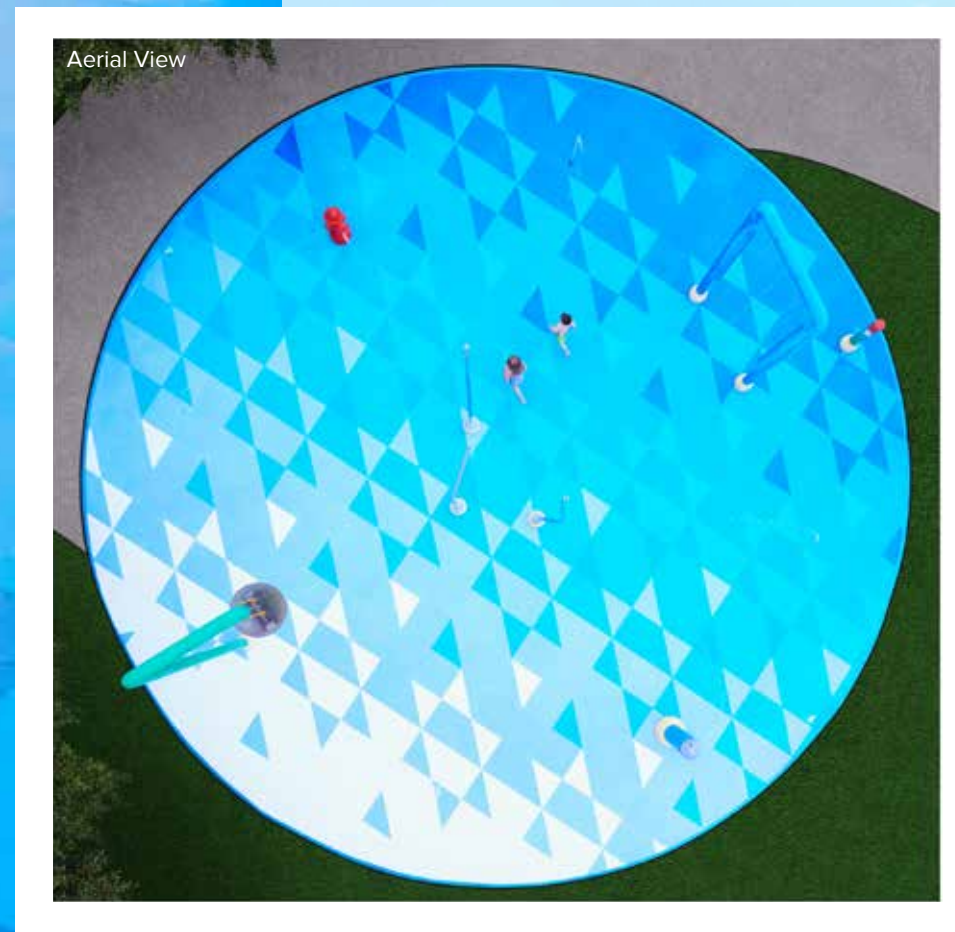

Designing with Color Gradients

Life Floor is unique to splash pad design in that our modular square tiles are easily transformed into dynamic, geometric patterns. **Gradient patterns** are a great way to utilize space.

The shift from color to color can also be used to make different play zones for multi-age splash features. **Multiple colors also hide dirt, leaves, and debris better than a monochrome floor.** Put it all together, and a beautifully designed surface creates a visual environment that invites children to run, jump, and splash.

More from Kelsi: “Life Floor originally created a design concept with only squares in a blue gradient for Cedarcrest. We decided to stay with a standard grid, but after looking at photos of the space to understand the context and size of the splash pad, we added triangles for visual interest in such a large area.”

Life Floor is available in three natural textures. Our Ripple texture has the highest traction rating when wet.



Ripple 2.0

Our enhanced Ripple texture has deeper grooves for anti-hydroplaning, a more defined texture, and a crisper, more polished look for your aquatic facility. Popularly used in underwater or low-depth applications such as splash decks, zero-depth entries, slide pads, and around spray features.

Design with Thickness

Life Floor tiles are available in 3/16", 3/8", and 7/8" thickness options.

Why is tile thickness important?

As tile thickness increases, so does critical fall height and safety. For aquatic environments with young children, we recommend using our 3/8" tile with Ripple, our most slip-resistant texture.
